

Front Base Assembly


Connect both arches (14 a, b) to form a complete arch. Then, connect the bottom tips of the arch to the front base (13). Be sure to use gentle force when snapping parts into place.








Position front and back base as pictured. Fully extend tunnel to prepare for connection to both bases. The tunnel will be used to connect both bases.



Face the end of the tunnel (15) with five hook and loop fasteners towards the front base. Tie the two straps located near the sew in label to the front base. The end of the tunnel with four hook and loop fasteners should face the back base. Slide fasteners through their appropriate slots on each base located as pictured below.






Attach spirals by placing the locks from the top and bottom ends into the right tower.



Connect the dome dish (9) to the top of the right tower, then attach the dome (10) to the top of the dish. Note: When both pieces are connected properly they will create a circular opening.




Attach the funnel (6) to the top of left tower, while lining up to the guides located on the top end of the tower and bottom of the funnel itself.









Attach right tower bottom (7) to the right side of the back base. Be sure to line up the opening closest to the bottom of the ramp to eliminate any obstruction or interference when play time begins.



Take the bridge (8) and connect it to the back base. Make sure to align all pieces properly using the rectangular guides located on the connecting ends of either pieces/parts. Music is activated by ball drops and by pressing the buttons on the bridge for music.



Connect both spiral pieces (12 a, b) to one another. Both pieces will snap into one another. Note: Once both pieces are connected each end will have a connector that will connect to the top and bottom of the right tower.



Battery Safety Information. This is serious!





Before you begin, install the batteries!


Before beginning, an adult must install fresh alkaline batteries. Here's how:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screws and battery compartment cover located under the bridge (8).
- 2. Install three (3) fresh 1.5V AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screws.




Back Base Assembly


To begin assembly, lay back base (1) on flat surface as pictured. Connect the left tower bottom (2) to the left side of the back base.



Connect ramp (11) to the right side of the back base. Note: The bottom of the ramp should be pushed down firmly to ensure it is fully connected.



Take tray 1 (3) and connect it to the left tower bottom. Note: Locate and match up rectangular cut out on both pieces to ensure proper alignment.



Attach the middle tower (4) to the tray in a stacking manner. Ensuring they are properly aligned and firmly connected.
